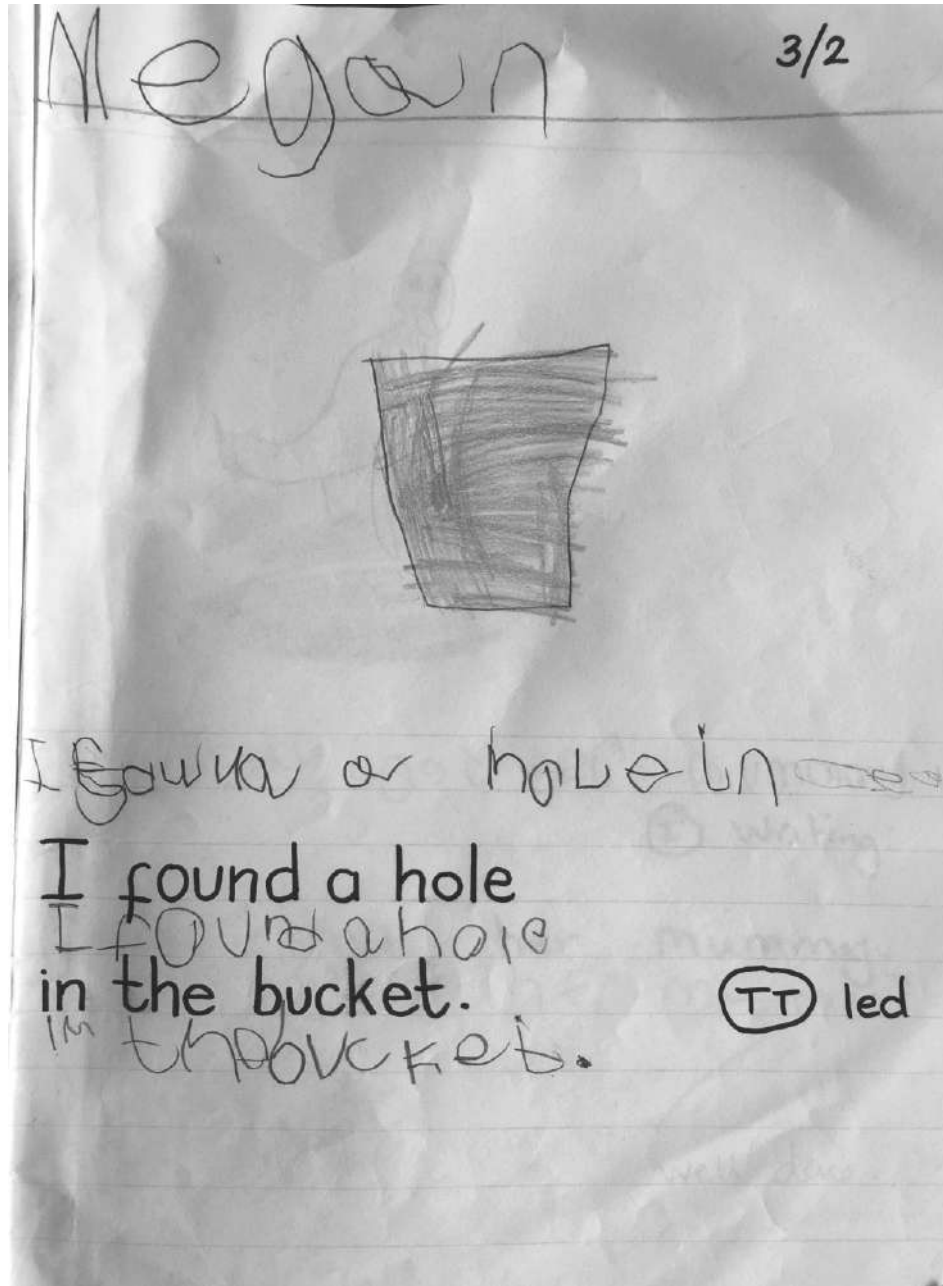
Texts A–F were all produced at school by different children as part of their class-based activities.

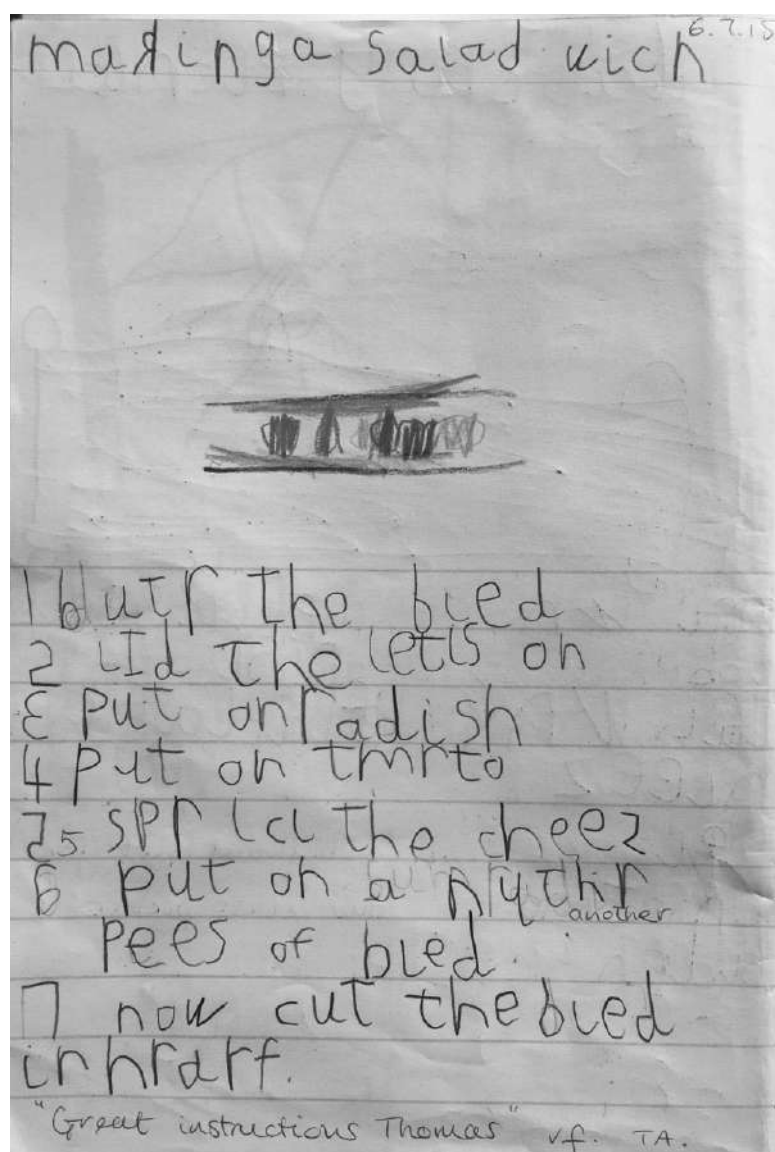
Text A

Text B was written by Thomas aged 5 years and 5 months in his writing journal. He was asked to produce some instructions.



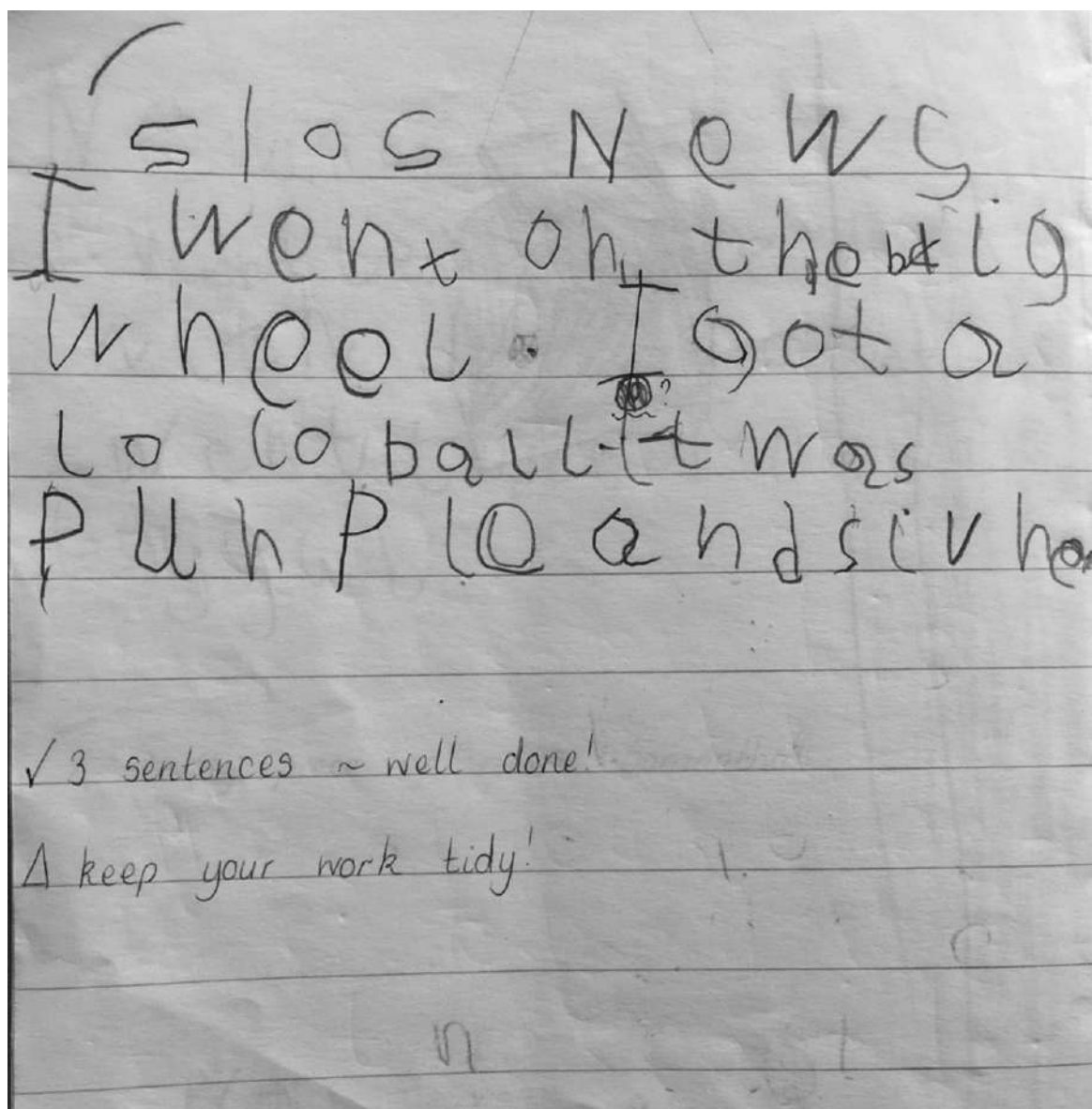

Text C was written by Sammy aged 5 years and 6 months in her writing book. It was part of a weekly exercise in which the children recounted a piece of personal news.

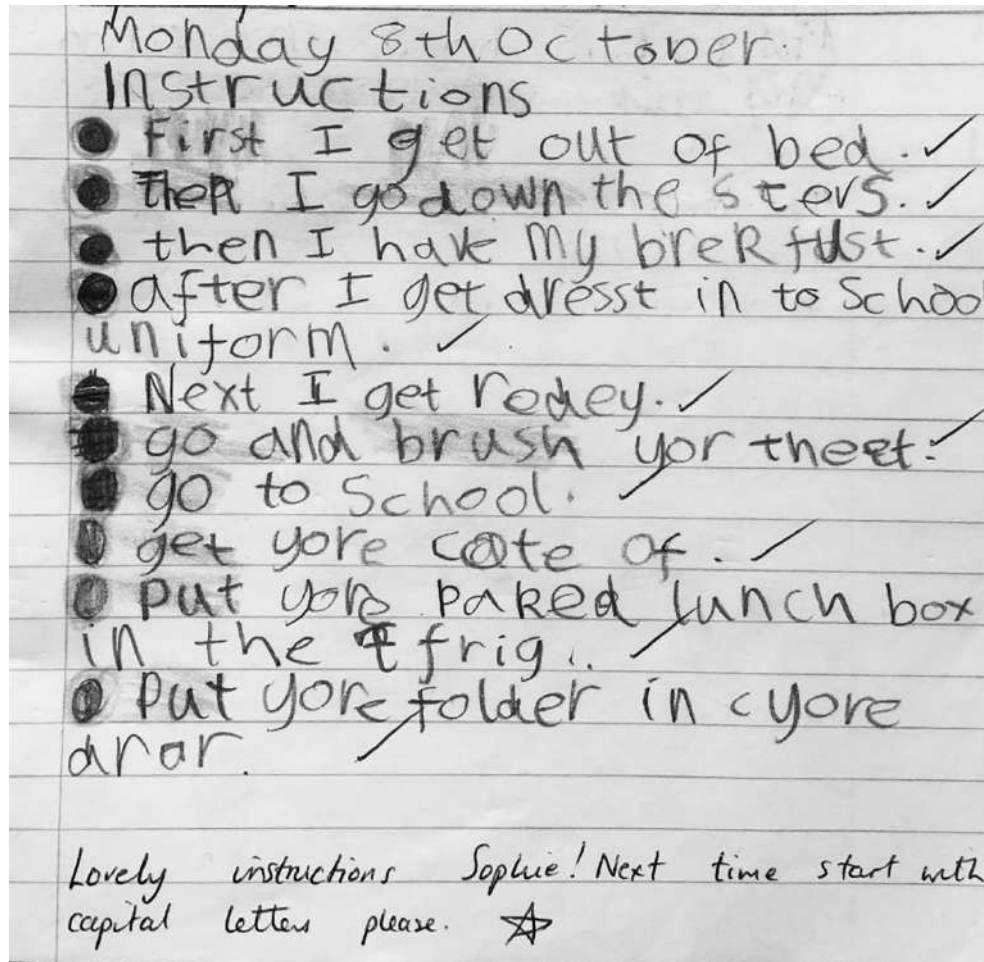
